Small bowl for mixing the clay

Filtered water in a spray bottle
Small plastic box for storing mixed clay
Rolling pin

Playing cards or measuring slats
Olive oil
Clay shaper, extra firm, black, #0
Fantastix, brush tip
Needle tool
Sponge sanding pad, 150 grit
Candle warmer
Teflon sheet

Round stainless steel or fused silica bowl with no lid

Kiln posts

Finishing Tools

Rotary tool, Dremel or Black and Decker

Collets, 1/8", 3/32"

Mini fiber wheels, course and extra fine

Slotted mandrels

Drum mandrel and sleeves, 80-, 120- and 240 grit

Sandpaper, 220- and 400 grit

For mokume-gane classes: Baldwin's Patina

For steel classes: Oxpho-blue Brownells patina
